Systems Vault Exchange Hosting offers Small and Medium Businesses the messaging and collaboration features generally only available to large corporations. Email is perhaps the most important communications tool in business today, but for many companies the cost of implementing reliable e-mail and group collaboration services can be overwhelming. Systems Vault enables organizations of all sizes to utilize the enterprise-class messaging, collaboration and group scheduling features offered by Microsoft Exchange Server 2007.

Systems Vault is the smart and affordable way to enable yourself and your employees to work smarter and communicate more effectively without an expensive capital outlay for software and servers not to mention the expense of backups and Systems Administration support.

Email to/from your own domain

Receive email from your company's own domain name with no setup fees except the cost of your domain registration.

Personal and Shared Calendars

Track your own schedule or use calendar sharing to check a co-worker's availability to attend meetings and events before scheduling the meeting. You can also create shared calendars for scheduling things such as current projects, conference rooms, resources and more.

Contacts

Keep your contacts and address book in a centralized location that is accessible from anywhere in the world. You can also create shared contact lists for use in storing things like customer addresses, donor lists, vendors and any other type of contacts your team needs to access.

Task Management

Assign tasks to yourself or co-workers anytime, anywhere. Tasking along with e-mail helps busy business owners and managers keep track of operations easily.

Stop SPAM with Systems Vault

Included with your Exchange account is SPAM and Anti-Virus filtering at the mail gateway so the messages never make it to your mailbox. Systems Vault utilizes an industry-leading SPAM filter effective at blocking SPAM without false positives (valid mail considered SPAM). If messages are blocked you will receive a daily message digest showing the Spam queue for your mailbox. If you want a message in the queue delivered you simply click on the message and it is released to your mailbox.



Outlook Web Access 2007

For users who are traveling or don't have access to rich communications tools like Microsoft Outlook, the Systems Vault service includes the use of Microsoft Outlook Web Access. Outlook Web Access (OWA) is a full-featured e-mail client similar to Microsoft Outlook 2007. OWA is securely accessible from anywhere in the world via a standard web browser and gives the end-user access to their company's e-mail, calendars, contacts, tasks, public folders and other business resources from a web browser!. New features in OWA include

- Spell Check
- Saved Signatures
- Rules Wizard

Outlook Mobile Access

Wirelessly access your Inbox, Calendars and more from phones which support Microsoft ActiveSync including Treo, SmartPhone, and others. There is no additional charge for this service.

Large Attachments

All Systems Vault servers are configured to allow the sending and receiving of large attachments (Messages up to 100MB).

Connect Outlook via HTTPS

Windows XP users using Outlook 2003/2007 can securely connect directly to the Systems Vault service without the need for a VPN.

No License Fees

With Systems Vault, you don't need to track CAL (Client Access Licenses) everything you need is included in one low monthly mailbox fee. Each user registered with the Systems Vault Service is assigned a Subscriber Access License (SAL) from Microsoft. The Standard license includes use of the Systems Vault Exchange 2007 service as well as use of Outlook software, Outlook Web Access, and Mobile Access. Your Subscriber Access License includes free upgrades to future versions of Microsoft Exchange Server.

Disaster Recovery Backups

Systems Vault has a comprehensive disaster recovery plan including nightly disaster recovery backups.
